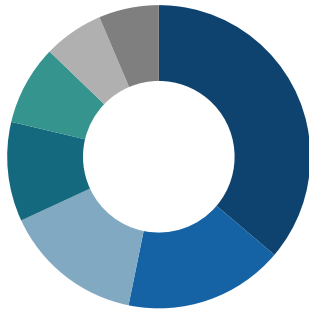

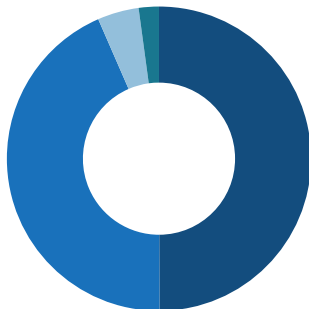
Percent of PAs by Specialty in Rhode Island



- 36.2% Surgical Subspecialties
- 17.0% All Other Specialties
- 14.9% Internal Medicine Subspecialties
- 10.6% Family Medicine
- 8.5% Urgent Care
- 6.4% Emergency Medicine
- 6.4% General Peds, General Internal Med

17% of PAs specialize in Primary Care (Primary Care includes Family Medicine [with and without Urgent Care], General Internal Medicine, and General Pediatrics)

Percent of PAs by Setting in Rhode Island



- 48.9% Physician Office or Clinic
- 42.6% Hospital Settings
- 4.3% Urgent Care Center
- 2.1% Other Settings

53.2% of PAs are employed by a Physician Group or Solo Practice

In Rhode Island

- ▣ A typical PA completes 73 patient visits per week
- ▣ A typical PA is on call 17 hours per month
- ▣ 78.9% of Rhode Island PAs would choose their career over again
